

## School Policies & Information Cont...

**Academic Policy-** (1) Each potential student must be pre-evaluated either by fax or in person a min. of 1 month prior to admission to class for course selected. This is to insure that the required service requirements have been met.  
(2) In lieu of actual academic grades the student will evaluate & test for a Merchant Mariners Document with **endorsement to be issued by the United States Coast Guard New Orleans Regional Exam Center**. Upon completion of selected course, **issuance will provide proof of academic achievement.**

**Attendance Policy-** Students are required to attend a minimum of 50 hours to complete course selected. Each student will sign in & out for class and dinner break daily on a "Student Sign In Sheet " issued @ sign in.

**Grievance Policy-** Students dissatisfied with the School's performance are to submit in writing a full description of the infraction in question. The Instructor and Administrator will investigate and submit a written finding in no more than 15 days following written grievance. Appropriate measures will be taken to reasonably satisfy the student's grievance.

**Disciplinary Policy-** Students will be required to submit to a DOT Drug Screen & Physical. **Failure of Drug Screen will be grounds for immediate forced withdrawal.**

**1.) Able Seaman—\$999.00**—(Training materials & USCG fees included) **7 day class-50 hours**

**Service Requirements for Able Seaman- Unlimited** -1080 8/or 720 12 hr. days deck service Oceans or Great Lakes, vessels 100 gross tons or over.

**Limited** -540 8/or 360 12 hr. days deck service, Waters other than Inland, vessels 100 gross tons or over.

**Special** -360 8/or 240 12 hr days deck service Oceans Or US Navigable waters, vessels 65 ft. in length or over.

**Special (OSV)** -180 8/or 120 12 hr days deck service on vessels over 15 gross tons.

**Service Requirements for Lifeboatman-**

a. 360 8/ 240 12 hr days on deck on vessels over 65 ft.;  
**Or** b. 720 8/ 480 12 hr days service on vessels over 65 ft. in other departments.

**Or** c. Credit for CG approved Lifeboatman Course School.

**2.) Qualified Member of the Engine Dept./Oiler- (QMED/Oiler)—\$999.00**—(Training materials & USCG fees included.) **7 day class- 50 hours**

**Service Requirements for QMED/Oiler-**

(A 60% calculation is used for total military sea service.)  
**180 8/or 120 12 hr days documented sea service in the engine dept. on board a steam or partially automated steam vessel of any hp. in a rating at least equal to that of wiper or coal passer.**

## School Policies & Information

**Tuition & Fees**-Listed below are tuition and fees for both Able Seaman w/ Lifeboatman and QMED w/Oiler courses:

**\$595.00** for tuition,  
**\$29.00** textbook usage fee,  
**\$85.00** for DOT drug screen & physical,  
**\$10.00** for 2 passport photographs.  
Included are fees for USCG evaluation (**\$95.00**), testing (**\$140.00**), and issuance of document (**\$45.00**).

*The above fees take into consideration financing.  
A \$500.00 down payment is required to finance.  
If no financing is required a \$250.00 discount applies to tuition portion of the costs outlined above.*
